

Frequent eye exams are indispensable to your eye health. Since the eye is a sensitive organ, changes that may not be noticeable to you can lead to difficulties if left undetected. Only your eye care professional has the specialized knowledge and precision instrumentation available to evaluate the general health of your eyes as well as the effectiveness of your contact lenses. For this reason, we have special steps **in addition to a routine eye exam** for contact lens wearers.

Just a few of these steps include:

- The fit of the contact lens on the eye
- A specialized contact lens prescription
- Assessing the amount of corneal oxygen levels and eye health after wearing the lens for several days.

Since some of these steps require that lenses be worn for several days, a follow-up visit is absolutely required for first-time contact lens wearers and may be required for existing contact lens wearers.

Because of the additional testing:

- A contact lens fitting fee of **\$75.00** is added to the routine exam fee for new users. Insurance may not cover this.
- A contact lens evaluation fee of **\$60.00** is added to the routine exam fee for existing users. Insurance may not cover this.

Included in the fee are the following:

- The initial testing during your visit
- Instructions on insertion and removal of the lenses
- One pair of trial lenses (if lenses are torn, an additional lens will be provided)
- Contact lens solution and contact lens case
- One-week follow-up visit

At least one follow-up visit may be required to evaluate the fit of the lens and its overall impact on the health of the patient. The follow-up visit is essential and must be performed for the prescription to be authorized (unless otherwise specified by the doctor). The follow-up visit is usually scheduled one week after the initial visit. Every other follow up thereafter will be \$20.00.
